CanTung is a 1,400 tpd underground and surface tungsten mine located approximately 310 km northeast of Watson Lake, YT in the Northwest Territories. As the mine is in a remote location, this is a fly in – fly out, camp operation. The work schedule for this position is 21 - 12 hour day shifts on, followed by 21 days off. Shift rotations are on Wednesdays. The company provides transportation from Vancouver, Campbell River, Kamloops, Smithers or Prince George, British Columbia, where employees board the company provided air charter to the mine site. Employees residing in Northern BC or the Yukon are provided with air transportation from Whitehorse or Watson Lake, YT to the mine site.

Qualifications:

CanTung is seeking a Certified Electronics Engineering Technologist for the surface, mill and underground operations maintenance program. A minimum of four years of experience, preferably in a mining or industrial environment is required.

Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Electrical Supervisor, the successful applicant will be responsible for the safe and efficient maintenance of PLC and Instrumentation control systems and components that are integral to the activities throughout the mine site. Duties include but are not limited to;
