Underground Mine Geologist

CanTung is a 1,200 tpd underground tungsten mine located approximately 310 km northeast of Watson Lake, YT in the Northwest Territories. As the mine is in a remote location, this is a fly in – fly out, camp operation. The work schedule for this position is 21 - 12 hour day shifts on, followed by 21 days off. Shift rotations are on Wednesdays. The company provides transportation from Vancouver, Campbell River, Kamloops, Smithers or Prince George, British Columbia, where employees board the company provided air charter to the mine site. Employees residing in Northern BC or the Yukon are provided with air transportation from Whitehorse or Watson Lake, YT to the mine site.

Job Description:

The ore at CanTung is hosted in a complex skarn deposit. This geologically challenging position requires an individual with strong lithological and structural mapping skills, the ability to compile, interpret and evaluate digital and paper information as part of a dynamic mining team.

The successful candidate will report directly to the Senior Mine Geologist. They will be responsible for underground mapping, core logging, grade control, sampling, data entry, as well as compiling data in a timely and useable format to work with the Engineering Department and Underground Operations in developing an extraction strategy.

A minimum of two years underground experience and demonstrated abilities to solve problems in a team environment are required. Computer skills must include Microsoft software proficiencies (Access, Excel and Word), while AutoCAD, Promine and especially Minesight experience will be considered assets.
